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SPRINGFIELD, ILLINOIS, May 20, 2010 - The State Board of Elections will conduct public hearings on a proposed administrative rule amending Title 26, Part 100 and Part 125. These amendments implement changes to the Campaign Finance Act resulting from the passage of Public Act 96-832.

The public hearings will take place at the same time as the Special Board Meetings on Wednesday, June 2, 2010 at the DeKalb County Legislative Center, 200 North Main Street, Room 100, Sycamore, Illinois and Thursday, June 3, 2010 at the Madison County Board Office, 157 North Main Street, Suite 203, Edwardsville, Illinois. The hearings are scheduled to begin at 1:00 p.m. and will last a minimum of one hour in both locations.

Comments will be accepted at both Board Meeting locations or may be submitted in writing to the Board's General Counsel, Steve Sandvoss, at 1020 South Spring Street, Springfield, IL 62704.

The State Board of Elections is an independent state agency charged with the responsibility of having general supervision over the administration of election laws of the State. Elections are administered locally by the State's 110 election authorities.

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
