
REPORT OF HEARING EXAMINER
Appeal of Civil Penalty Assessment
For Delinquently Filing the 2010 June Semi-Annual Report

The Semi-Annual Report was received by the Board on August 5, 2010, 12 days late, resulting in a civil penalty assessment of \$900. Additionally, the Committee had previously been assessed a \$225 civil penalty (not appealed, paid) for late filing of the June 2008 Semi-Annual Report, an \$800 civil penalty (appealed, appeal denied, paid) for late filing of the December 2008 Semi-Annual Report, and a \$75 civil penalty (not appealed, paid) for late filing of the December 2009 Semi-Annual Report. The total assessment is \$900.

Steven Aisen, the Chairman of the Committee, filed a Waiver of Appearance and submitted on the Appeal Affidavit the following:

On the affidavit, Mr. Aisen states that the Committee did not receive a notice to file the Semi-Annual Report. He adds that the Committee is essentially inactive, and the only money being spent is to pay fines to the Board.

I recommend the appeal be denied for lack of an adequate defense. The Committee was sent a packet and a reminder letter for the Semi-Annual Report, which should have been sufficient notification. Additionally, the Committee should have been especially aware of the filing deadline, having been fined three times previously for late filings of Semi-Annual Report. In any case, it is the Committee's responsibility to know about and meet the filing deadlines. If the Committee intends to remain inactive, I suggest they file a Final Report to remove the need for future report filings. If this recommendation is accepted by the Board, the total assessment of \$900 will be due and owing. (As of 6/30/10, this Committee reported a funds available balance of \$2897.85.)





MOTION TO SETTLE CIVIL PENALTY ASSESSMENTS AND RECONSIDER FINAL ORDER

Now Comes the Respondent committee, by and through its attorney, Burton S. Odelson and moves to settle the outstanding civil penalty assessments against the committee which originally totaled \$3,825.00. In support thereof, the Respondent committee states as follows:

1. Citizen for Collins is a new committee formed by Antoine Collins for his election campaign for Alderman in the city of Calumet City. Mr. Collins is a novice and had never before been active in the political arena.
2. Mr. Collins attempted to do all of his disclosure forms himself but was not successful in reporting in a timely fashion.
3. Mr. Collins has retained the services of my firm to help file timely and accurate reports.
4. Mr. Collins is in his second year of a four year term and does not stand for reelection until 2013.
5. In light of the fact that the Committee has little funds, (\$35.00) the committee respectfully requests that the penalty be reduced to \$500.00 and the committee be given 90 days


to pay.

6. Other civil penalties have been settled with committees which are far more substantial than Respondent. This is an Alderman of a ward in the City of Calumet City with virtually no funds.
