

POSTING IN ACCORD WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF
5 ILCS 140/4:

The State Board of Elections was created by the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, to have "general supervision over the administration of the registration and election laws throughout the State." Public Act 78-918, enacted October 22, 1973, established the structure and specific functions of the Board. The Board exercises the powers and duties in accord with Section 1A-8 of the Election Code. The Board acts as a policy-making body and employs 76 full-time professional non-partisan staff members to assist the Board in its carrying out its policies.

The present officers and members of the bipartisan Board are as noted hereinabove, upper right. The Board maintains its primary office at the Springfield address noted above, and its branch office at the Chicago address noted above. A block diagram showing the State Board of Elections' functional subdivisions is attached hereto. The total amount of its requested operating budget for fiscal year 2016 is \$28,278,100.
